POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

Lifeguard - \$9.02/hr

Duties include enforcing rules, ensuring guest safety, providing water rescue assistance and first aid as needed, ensuring the correct use of water attractions, attending all required training sessions, and performing general park cleanup duties. Must be able to sit or stand for long periods of time in varying weather and water temperatures. All lifeguard applicants must complete the NASCO Waterpark Shallow Water Lifeguard Course prior to employment (two courses will be offered in the spring). Course prerequisites: Must be able to swim 50 yards using crawl or breast stroke and be able to recover a 10 lb. brick from a depth of 5 feet.

NASCO Fee (NEW Lifeguards): \$60.00

NASCO Fee (RETURNING Lifeguards): \$45.00

Concessions - \$8.32/hr

Duties include preparing and serving food and beverages according to health department guidelines, collecting cash, making change, operating a point of sale system, keeping foodservice and work areas clean, attending all required training sessions and providing customer service to guests. Must be able to sit or stand for long periods of time in varying temperatures.

Cashier - \$8.32/hr

Duties include providing customer service, collecting cash, making change, operating a point of sale system, making retail sales, conducting inventory, completing office duties including opening and closing procedures and knowledge of park rules and regulations. Must be able to sit or stand for long periods of time in varying temperatures.

Gate Attendant & Waterpark Attendant - \$8.32/hr

Duties include providing customer service, performing turnstile operations, enforcing safety rules and performing general park cleanup duties as well as dispatching guests on attractions and enforcing height restrictions and swimsuit policies. Must be able to sit or stand for long periods of time in varying weather and water temperatures. All waterpark attendant applicants must complete the NASCO Waterpark Attendant Course prior to employment (a course will be offered in the spring).

NASCO Fee (ALL Waterpark Attendants): \$40.00

Party Host - \$8.32/hr

Duties include providing customer service, facilitating guest birthday parties and private rentals, and performing general park cleanup duties. Primarily works only when parties or groups are scheduled. Must be able to sit or stand for long periods of time in varying weather temperatures.
